- MassOptions is a free service for older adults looking for help, such as inhome care, an individual with a disability seeking help to live independently, or a family member or caregiver trying to locate services for a loved one.
- MassOptions connects older adults, individuals with disabilities and their caregivers with agencies and organizations that can best meet their needs.
