## Helping you live better, longer

### Do you need a Measles Booster?

(If so, call your pharmacy for an appointment)

- YES for those born between 1957-1968 without knowledge of immunity or having received a "live" vaccine
- YES for unvaccinated adults and children >1 year old
- YES for an unvaccinated baby >6 months of age in area with an outbreak
- · NO for those born before 1957
- NO for those individuals vaccinated after 1968
- NO for those who are pregnant or are immunocompromised

## **Health Tip**

It's tick season. What can you do? Wear light clothing for easier identification. Use insect repellent with DEET or Permethrin. Perform daily tick checks. If you find an engorged deer tick, call or send us a portal message for more information.
